The Climate Change Professional (CCP®) is the credential reflecting your dedication to professional development and your competency in the fundamentals of climate change preparedness and strategic planning. This checklist has been designed to make it easier for you to track your progress in satisfying the requirements for earning the CCP® credential.

## **CCP® Exam Modules:**

You are not required to take ACCO courses to satisfy requirements, the courses referenced adjacent to each exam module are recommended when preparing for the exam. If ACCO has notified you that a requirement has been waived, you do not need to take the corresponding course module or exam.

In those instances, you may consider that corresponding requirement to be a general elective. With or without those exceptions, you must demonstrate at least 14 hours of formal training in subject matter areas covered under the "Core Competencies for Climate Change Offices and Professionals" in addition to satisfying the core curriculum requirements above.
